What is the Federal Regional Transportation Plan?

In February 2019, the SANDAG Board of Directors approved an action plan to develop a bold new vision for the 2021 Regional Plan with the goal to transform the way people and goods move throughout the San Diego region by providing compelling alternatives to driving. While work progresses to develop this new vision, SANDAG has been preparing the 2019 Federal Regional Transportation Plan (2019 Federal RTP) to retain air quality conformity approval from the U.S. Department of Transportation and protect funding for the region's transportation investments. Once the 2021 Regional Plan is adopted by the SANDAG Board of Directors, it will be submitted to both the state and federal governments. In the meantime, SANDAG continues to take action to improve mobility and reduce emissions in the San Diego region.

The draft 2019 Federal RTP, including the list of projects and programs, network maps, performance measure results, and social equity analysis will be available for public review and comment through October 22, 2019.
