



San Diego Forward: The 2021 Regional Plan Community-Based Organizations Outreach Network

To reach out to community members who have traditionally been underserved and underrepresented in the planning process, SANDAG partnered with 12 Community Based Organizations from around the region. These organizations have created programs to engage stakeholders from low-income communities, limited-English speaking populations, the disabled community, and seniors to ensure that their voices are heard and that the 2021 Regional Plan is socially equitable.

Chula Vista Community Collaborative (CVCC) – The CVCC is an established and respected community-based collaborative in the South Bay. The CVCC draws together all sectors of the local community to develop coordinated strategies and systems that protect the health and safety of residents, develop economic resources, promote local leadership, enhance the environment, and contribute to the celebration of and respect for cultural diversity. The CVCC currently has over 290-member organizations and 800 members. The CVCC acts as a platform from which to launch effective new initiatives to improve quality of life. The CVCC is the umbrella for a variety of programs and committees. The most notable infrastructure of the CVCC is the network of Family Resource Centers that have been created and sustained by collective effort.
