



San Diego Forward: The 2021 Regional Plan Community-Based Organizations Outreach Network

To reach out to community members who have traditionally been underserved and underrepresented in the planning process, SANDAG partnered with 12 Community Based Organizations from around the region. These organizations have created programs to engage stakeholders from low-income communities, limited-English speaking populations, the disabled community, and seniors to ensure that their voices are heard and that the 2021 Regional Plan is socially equitable.

El Cajon Collaborative (ECC) – Established in 1992, the ECC is one of the oldest collaboratives in San Diego County. Currently, the Collaborative has an established network of over seventy partner agencies (health clinics, social services agencies, educational institutions, faith communities and government entities) whose target populations vary. Their goals include leveraging resources to help facilitate vital services for newcomers and other families in need, increase coordination and collaboration to meet the growing needs for serving homeless and improving community resources including public transportation options.
